- Supplied as Word Document or PDF
- Fully edited and checked for grammar/spelling prior to submission
- Minimum of two pages (including images)

Images

- High resolution images to be provided. Minimum size 1MB (blurry/pixelated images won't be used)
- Supplied as email attachments, Dropbox or Google Drive folders (or alternate sharing method)
- Must be supplied with corresponding file names (e.g. 'Figure 1')
- Position in article to be recommended by the contributor. The preferred method is to write the corresponding file name in red or place into a box in the body of the text where the image is suggested to go. Please include caption and photography acknowledgements (see example below).
- Each article has an image in the header (a 'hero' image). Please supply/denote which image you would like as your 'hero'.

Please note, all efforts will be made to place images as suggested, however spacing/sizing may influence their position.

Submission Example

Egypt 20 pounds polymer banknote

The new Egyptian polymer £20 has made it to the cash drawer a year after the introduction of the £10 in July 2022. I had been keeping an eye on the introduction of the new Egyptian polymer series as there were hints, then suggestions and tentative announcements prior to last year's actual arrival of the country's first polymer banknote.

Egypt's new £20 is said to be the first of its kind in the country as new cutting-edge technology enables the blind and visually impaired to identify the denomination by feel as there are tactile ADA Braille dots impressed on the top left corner of the note.

The note is green, blue and yellow, very different in colour to the 2016 issue that was green, purple, pink and brown, and while both depict the Great Mosque of Muhammad Ali Pasha (or the Alabaster Mosque) in Cairo, the image is larger on the new issue than the previous one.
